**ORDER GRANTING PLAINTIFF’S MOTION FOR
SUMMARY JUDGMENT**

Upon consideration of Plaintiff Hong Kong Leyuzhen Technology Co. Ltd.’s (“Plaintiff”) Motion for Summary Judgment (“Motion”) against the remaining identified Schedule “A” Defendants (“Defendants”) and good cause having been shown, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:**

1. There are no genuine issues of material fact that Plaintiff is the owner of the asserted Copyright Protected Images;
2. There are no genuine issues of material fact that the Court has specific personal jurisdiction over the Defendants;
3. There are no genuine issues of material fact that the Defendants have displayed the Copyrighted Protected Images without authorization in connection with the solicitation of purchases by the consuming public;
4. There are no genuine issues of material fact that the Defendants copied or obtained Plaintiff’s Copyright Protected Images directly from the company’s website or through an

unlicensed, unauthorized third party; and

5. There are no genuine issues of material fact that the Defendants' infringement was committed without an investigation as to rights held by any other third parties, thereby warranting a finding of willful infringement of the asserted Copyright Protected Images.

Based on the foregoing determinations, the Court hereby **GRANTS** Plaintiff's Motion for Summary Judgment.

THIS COURT FURTHER FINDS that the Defendants are liable for direct federal copyright infringement (17 U.S.C. § 504).

THIS COURT FURTHER ORDERS that:

1. Defendants, their officers, agents, servants, employees, attorneys, and all persons acting for, with, by, through, under, or in active concert with them be permanently enjoined and restrained from: a. using the Copyright Protected Images or any reproductions, infringing copies, or colorable imitations in any manner in connection with the distribution, marketing, advertising, offering for sale, or sale of any product that is not a genuine Rotita product or not authorized by Plaintiff to be sold in connection with the Copyright Protected Images;

2. passing off, inducing, or enabling others to sell or pass off any product as a genuine Rotita product or any other product produced by Plaintiff, that is not Plaintiff's or not produced under the authorization, control, or supervision of Plaintiff and approved by Plaintiff for sale under the Copyright Protected Images;

3. committing any acts calculated to cause consumers to believe that Defendants' products are those sold under the authorization, control, or supervision of Plaintiff, or are sponsored by, approved by, or otherwise connected with Plaintiff; and

4. manufacturing, shipping, delivering, holding for sale, transferring or otherwise

moving, storing, distributing, returning, or otherwise disposing of, in any manner, products or inventory not manufactured by or for Plaintiff, nor authorized by Plaintiff to be sold or offered for sale, and which bear any of Plaintiff's copyrights, including the Copyright Protected Images, or any reproductions, infringing copies or colorable imitations.

THIS COURT FURTHER ORDERS that:

1. Defendants and any third party with actual notice of this Order who is providing services for any of the Defendants, or in connection with any of the Defendants' Internet Stores, including, without limitation, any online marketplace platforms such as AliExpress, Amazon Payments, Inc. ("Amazon"), Walmart Inc. ("Walmart"), and Wish U.S. Holdings LLC and ContextLogic Inc. d/b/a Wish.com ("WISH"), Alibaba Group Holding Ltd. ("Alibaba") (collectively, the "Third Party Providers"), shall within seven (7) calendar days of receipt of this Order cease: a. using, linking to, transferring, selling, exercising control over, or otherwise owning the Defendant Internet Stores, or any other online marketplace account that is being used to sell or is the means by which Defendants could continue to sell infringing goods using the Copyright Protected Images; and operating and/or hosting websites that are involved with the distribution, marketing, advertising, offering for sale, or sale of any product bearing the Copyright Protected Images or any reproductions, infringing copies or colorable imitations thereof that is not a genuine Rotita product or not authorized by Plaintiff to be sold in connection with the Copyright Protected Images.

2. Upon Plaintiff's request, those with notice of this Order, including the Third Party Providers as defined in Paragraph 2, shall within seven (7) calendar days after receipt of such notice, disable and cease displaying any advertisements used by or associated with Defendants in connection with the sale of infringing goods using the Copyright Protected Images.

3. Pursuant to 17 U.S.C. § 504(c)(2), Plaintiff is awarded statutory damages from each of the Defendants in the amount of five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00), which shall be enhanced to fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000.00) for the willful infringement of the Copyright Protected Images.

4. Any Third Party Providers holding funds for Defendants, including AliExpress, Amazon, Walmart, PayPal, Alibaba and WISH, shall, within seven (7) calendar days of receipt of this Order, permanently restrain and enjoin any accounts connected to Defendants or the Defendant Internet Stores from transferring or disposing of any funds (up to the statutory damages awarded in Paragraph 4 above) or other of Defendants' assets.

5. All monies (up to the amount of the statutory damages awarded in Paragraph 4 above) currently restrained in Defendants' financial accounts, including monies held by Third Party Providers such as AliExpress, Amazon, Walmart, PayPal, Alibaba and WISH, are hereby released to Plaintiff as partial payment of the above-identified damages, and Third Party Providers, such as AliExpress, Amazon, Walmart, Alibaba and WISH, are ordered to release to Plaintiff the amounts from Defendants' financial accounts within fourteen (14) calendar days of receipt of this Order.

6. Until Plaintiff has recovered full payment of monies owed to it by any Defendant, Plaintiff shall have the ongoing authority to commence supplemental proceedings under Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 69.


7. In the event that Plaintiff identifies any additional online marketplace accounts or financial accounts owned by Defendants, Plaintiff may send notice of any supplemental proceeding, including a citation to discover assets, to Defendants by e-mail at any e-mail addresses provided for Defendants by third parties.

8. The five thousand dollar (\$5,000) surety bond posted by Plaintiff is hereby released via

certified mail to its counsel, Gokalp Bayramoglu of Bayramoglu Law Offices LLC. The Clerk of the Court is directed to return the surety bond previously deposited with the Clerk of the Court to Gokalp Bayramoglu, 1540 West Warm Springs Road Suite 100, Henderson Nevada 89014
