## EXTENDED TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER

appear before this Court, on May 28, 2024 at 9:00 A.M., to show cause why an order should not be issued pursuant to Rule 65 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure converting the hereby extended temporary restraining order to a Preliminary Injunction.
