**ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR ELECTRONIC SERVICE OF PROCESS
BY E-MAIL AND/OR PUBLICATION**


Before the Court is Plaintiff Shenzhen Duoleduo Technology Co. Ltd.'s, *ex parte* Motion for Electronic Service of Process by e-mail and/or Publication (the "Motion") that requests an order authorizing electronic service of process on the Individuals, Corporations, Limited Liability Companies, Partnerships, and Unincorporated Associations Identified in Schedule "A" to the Complaint (the "Defendants") via electronic mail with the relevant documents attached ("e-mail") and via website posting. The Court, having considered the Motion and finding good cause hereby grants Plaintiff's Motion.

It is hereby **ORDERED and ADJUDGED** that:

Plaintiff may provide notice of the proceedings in this case to the Defendants, including notice of the preliminary injunction hearing, service of process pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 4(f)(3), and any future motions, by electronically publishing a link to the Complaint, this Order, and other relevant documents on a website, and by 1) sending an e-mail with the relevant documents attached to the e-mail addresses provided by each Defendant on the Defendant's online store or website or

2) by sending an e-mail to the e-mail addresses provided for each Defendant by third parties in response to the Temporary Restraining Order [ECF No. 16]. The Clerk of the Court is directed to issue a single original summons in the name of “The Individuals, Corporations, Limited Liability Companies, Partnerships and Unincorporated Associations Identified in Schedule A” that shall apply to all Defendants. The combination of providing notice via electronic publication and e-mail, along with any notice that the Defendants receive from payment processors, shall constitute notice reasonably calculated under all circumstances to apprise the Defendants of the pendency of the action and afford them the opportunity to present their objections.
