**ORDER RESETTING PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION HEARING AND BRIEFING SCHEDULE**

This matter is before the Court on Plaintiff’s Motion for Preliminary Injunction, ECF No. 23.<sup>1</sup> The Court held a hearing on Plaintiff’s motion on December 16, 2025, at which Plaintiff’s counsel informed the Court that Plaintiff had failed to serve Defendants with notice of the preliminary injunction hearing, as required by the Court’s Order Setting Preliminary Injunction Hearing and Briefing Schedule, ECF No. 26. *See also* Fed. R. Civ. P. 65(a)(1) (“The court may issue a preliminary injunction only on notice to the adverse party.”). Accordingly, it is hereby **ORDERED AND ADJUDGED** as follows:

The Preliminary Injunction Hearing in this matter is **RESET** for **Tuesday, December 23, 2025, at 11:30 AM** before the Honorable Eduardo I. Sanchez in Courtroom 6 of the C. Clyde Atkins United States Courthouse, located at 301 N. Miami Avenue in Miami, Florida. Defendants shall appear at that hearing and show cause, if any they have, why they, their agents, officers, and

employees, and all other persons and entities in active concert or participation with them, should not be restrained and preliminarily enjoined pursuant to Plaintiff's Motion for Preliminary Injunction. In addition,

- a. Plaintiff must serve Defendants with a copy of this Order and file proof of service of this Order on the record **by 8:00 PM today—December 16, 2025**. If Plaintiff has not yet served its Motion for Preliminary Injunction, ECF No. 23, on Defendants, it must also do so and file proof of service of the Motion for Preliminary Injunction (regardless of when the motion was served) on the record **by 8:00 PM today—December 16, 2025**.
- b. Any response or opposition to Plaintiff's Motion for Preliminary Injunction, as well as notice of any exhibits, things, or documents that Defendants reasonably anticipate using at the Preliminary Injunction Hearing, must be served on Plaintiff's counsel and filed with the Court, along with proof of service, **by Friday, December 19, 2025**.
- c. Plaintiff shall file any reply memorandum **by Monday, December 22, 2025**.
