**ORDER RE-SETTING PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION HEARING**

On February 20, 2026, the Honorable Ed Artau, United States District Judge, extended the Temporary Restraining Order issued in this matter. [ECF No. 33]. Judge Artau also referred Plaintiff's Motion for a Preliminary Injunction to the undersigned Magistrate Judge. The Temporary Restraining Order is set to expire on March 6, 2026.

This Court held a preliminary injunction hearing on March 3, 2026, where Plaintiff explained it had served Defendant on February 27, 2026. Thus, Defendant was only given one business day notice of the Preliminary Injunction Hearing. In order to provide Defendant with sufficient notice of the Preliminary Injunction Hearing, the Court will re-set the Preliminary Injunction Hearing.

**Accordingly**, a hearing for the preliminary injunction is set via videoconference on **March 5, 2026, at 9:00 a.m.**, at which time Defendant and/or any other affected persons may challenge the appropriateness of the Temporary Restraining Order and move to dissolve the same and the

Court will take evidence and hear argument on Plaintiff's request for a preliminary injunction. To access the hearing, all parties shall login to Zoom using the following information:

Plaintiff should be prepared to present evidence to establish its entitlement to a preliminary injunction. Likewise, Defendant may also present evidence at the hearing and may file a written response to Plaintiff's Motion for Preliminary injunction on or before March 5, 2026, at 9:00 a.m.
