**ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR ALTERNATE SERVICE BY E-MAIL
AND/OR ELECTRONIC PUBLICATION ON DEFENDANT**

Before the Court is Plaintiff Shenzhen Peishi Advertising Media Co. Ltd's *Ex Parte* Motion for Alternate Service of Process by E-Mail and/or Electronic Publication on Defendant (the "Motion") that requests an order authorizing alternate service of process on MIKESIER (the "Defendant") via electronic mail ("e-mail") and via website posting. The Court, having considered the Motion, and finding good cause, hereby grants Plaintiff's Motion.

It is hereby **ORDERED and ADJUDGED** that:

Plaintiff may provide notice of the proceedings in this case to the Defendant, including notice of the preliminary injunction hearing, service of process pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 4(f)(3), and any future motions, by electronically publishing a link to the Complaint, this Order, and other relevant documents on a website, and by 1) sending an e-mail to the e-mail addresses provided by Defendant on the Defendant's online stores or websites or 2) by sending an e-mail to the e-mail addresses provided for Defendant by third parties in response to the Temporary Restraining Order [ECF No. 15]. The Clerk of the Court is directed to issue an original summons in the name of the Defendant. The combination of providing notice via electronic publication and e-mail, along with

any notice that the Defendant receives from payment processors, shall constitute notice reasonably calculated under all circumstances to apprise the Defendant of the pendency of the action and afford it the opportunity to present its objections.
