ORDER ON *EX PARTE* MOTION TO EXTEND TEMPORARY RESTRAINING

ORDER


THIS CAUSE is before the Court upon Plaintiff's *Ex Parte* Motion to Extend Temporary Restraining Order, ECF No. [15]. The Court has considered the Motion, the record in this case, the applicable law, and is otherwise fully advised. Plaintiff argues good cause exists to extend the order because "Plaintiff has not yet been able to obtain discovery regarding the identification and email addresses for the Defendants." ECF No. [15] at 3. Plaintiff has served the temporary restraining order, ECF No. [12], and expedited discovery requests upon third-party platform Amazon, but have yet to receive the requested information. ECF No. [15] at 2. The Court finds good cause exists to extend the Temporary Restraining Order for fourteen days, as the possibility of irreparable harm to Plaintiff remains.

Accordingly, it is **ORDERED AND ADJUDGED** as follows:

- 1) The Temporary Restraining Order entered by this Court on January 8, 2026, **ECF No. [12]**, is **EXTENDED** and shall remain in effect for fourteen (14) additional calendar

days up to and including February 5, 2026.
