ORDER AUTHORIZING EXPEDITED DISCOVERY

This matter being before the Court on Plaintiff Hong Kong Leyuzhen Technology Co. Limited's Motion for Expedited Discovery (the "Motion") against the Defendant, Aling's small shop, as listed below and in Exhibit 2 to the First Amended Complaint (the "Defendant").

After reviewing the Motion and the accompanying documents, this Court GRANTS the motion as follows:

1. Plaintiff is authorized to issue expedited written discovery pursuant to Federal Rules of Civil Procedure 33, 34, 36, and 45 to Defendant, and any third party with actual notice of this Order who is providing services to Defendant or in connection with any of Defendant's Online Marketplaces, including, without limitation, any online marketplace platforms such as Alibaba, Temu, eBay Inc., AliExpress, Amazon.com Inc., Wish.com, Dhgate, and Tiktok.com

(collectively the “Third Party Providers”), shall, within seven (7) calendar days after receipt of such notice, provide to PLAINTIFF expedited discovery, including copies of documents and records in such person’s or entity’s possession or control relating to:

- a. the identities and locations of Defendant, its affiliates, officers, agents, servants, employees, attorneys, confederates and any persons acting in active concert or participation with them, including all known contact information and all associated e-mail addresses; and
- b. the nature of Defendant operations and all associated sales, methods of payments for services and financial information, including without limitation, identifying information associated with the Online Marketplace and Defendant’s financial accounts, as well as providing a full accounting of Defendant’s sales and listing history related to their respective Online Marketplaces.

2. Any third party impacted by this Order may move for appropriate relief.
